

Concert Dress

Female Choir Members

- 1) Your gown should reach your ankles when standing. If it is too long, you may trip on stairs or risers. When sitting, your gown needs to come to at least mid-calf.
- 2) You must wear black stockings and a black slip. If you choose to wear knee-high hose, your dress must cover the tops, and come down to mid-calf when sitting.
- 3) If you choose to carry a small purse or bag, it must fit under the jacket, and not be visible when standing.
- 4) Your pearl necklace should fit along the neckline of the dress. In other words, not a choker and not down to your belly button. No pendants on the necklace. The original suggested length (end to end) was 17 inches. This will vary slightly depending on the size of the person's neck. Pearl earrings should be a single pearl stud, not a dangle or other type.
- 5) Black soft-soled shoes, preferably closed toe. Soft soles are required for the California Theatre.
- 6) A scarf should not be worn for regular season concerts. For holiday or seasonal (e.g. Christmas) concerts, a colored scarf is sometimes worn.

Male Choir Members

Black tuxedo with white tux shirt and black bow tie. No vest for regular concerts. Black socks and black shoes. No low-cut socks or noisy shoes; soft soled preferred.
